A Memorial, to be Registered pursuant to the Statute in that behalf, of a Conveyance by Deed, bearing date

the Twentieth day of November in the year of our Lord One Thousand Eight Hundred and Fifty Five at the City of Toronto, in the Province of Canada, by Frederick Widdow and William Benjamin Robinson, of the City of Toronto, in the County of York, and Province aforesaid, Esquires, the Attornies of the Canada Company, incorporated under and by virtue of an Act made and passed by the Parliament of Great Britain and Ireland, in the Sixth Year of the Reign of His Majesty King George the Fourth, intituled, "An Act to enable His Majesty to grant to a Company to be incorporated by charter, to be called 'The Canada Company,' certain Lands in the Province of Upper Canada, and to invest the said Company with certain powers, and to assign and for other purposes relating thereto," whereby the said Attornies of the said Company did, in consideration of the sum of Seventy pounds five shillings and six pence lawful money of the Province of Canada, to them as such Attornies as aforesaid paid

Grant and Release to Joseph Carr of the Township of Riddulph County of Huron

and Province aforesaid, Esquire that certain Parcel or Tract of Land, situate as follows: composing Lot Twenty Five in the Fourteenth concession

of the said Township of Riddulph

containing by admeasurement One Hundred acres of Land, be the same more or less: and all the right, title, and interest of the said Canada Company, to and in the same, and every part thereof: To have and to hold unto the said Joseph Carr his Heirs and Assigns, for ever. Which said Deed of Conveyance is witnessed by Ronald McDonald and Thomas Collier of the City of Toronto aforesaid, Esquires

And this Memorial thereof is hereby required to be Registered by them the said Frederick Widdow and William Benjamin Robinson, Attornies of the said Canada Company as aforesaid.
