Know all Men by these Presents, that **We**

Doobittle of the same place yeoman*

Are jointly and severally held and firmly bound unto our Sovereign Lord the King in the Sum of Two Hundred Pounds, lawful Currency of the Province aforesaid, to be paid unto our said Lord the King, or His Heirs and Successors; for which payment, well and truly to be made, We bind ourselves, our and each of our Heirs, Executors, and Administrators, jointly and severally, firmly by these Presents, Sealed with our Seals, at *Corow* in the District and Province aforesaid, *this 26th* day of *September* in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty *two*

The Condition of this Obligation is such, that whereas a License of Marriage has this day issued from the Office of the Lieutenant Governor of the said Province of Upper Canada, for the purpose of joining together in Holy Matrimony

*Joseph Parr of the Township of Carleton
Yeoman and Jane Kennedy of the Town-
ship of Haldimand aforesaid Spinsters*

Now if it shall appear that there is no affinity, consanguinity, pre-contract, or any other lawful cause or impediment, to hinder their being so joined together, as aforesaid, then this obligation to be null and void, otherwise to remain in full force and virtue.
